COUNTRY PROFILES



ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA

Antigua and Barbuda is located in the Eastern Caribbean at the southern end of the Leeward Islands. It is comprised of the islands of Antigua, Barbuda and the uninhabited Redonda and covers a total land area of 442 km² (108 sq mi). The limestone and coral islands are mostly low-lying with some higher volcanic areas. Northern Antigua consists of rolling hills covered in scrub. A fertile plain lies at the centre with volcanic hills and valleys in the south. Barbuda is a very flat coral island. The highest point above sea level is 402 m (1,330 ft) and the average rainfall is 1,067 mm (42 inches) per year.

Antigua and Barbuda's economy is service-based, with tourism, financial, and Government services representing the key sources of employment and income. Tourism is the leading foreign exchange earner accounting for more than half of the country's GDP. In 2001, agriculture's contribution to GDP was 4% with the major products being cotton, vegetables, pineapples and livestock. Agricultural production is focused on the domestic market and constrained by a limited water supply and labour shortage stemming from the lure of higher wages in tourism and construction.



THE BAHAMAS

The Commonwealth of the Bahamas is an archipelago of islands cays spread over a total area of 161,000 km² (100,000 mi²). The Bahamas lies to the northeast of Cuba and 80 km off the southeast coast of Florida in the USA at its closest point. The islands are low, flat, coral formations with some low rounded hills. Twenty-nine of the islands are permanently inhabited and only 0.8% of the barren windswept land is arable. The highest point above sea level is 63 m (206 ft) and the average rainfall is 1,320mm (52 inches) per year. The Bahamas economy is heavily dependent on tourism and offshore banking. Tourism accounts for more than 60% of GDP and employs half of the country's labour force, either directly or indirectly. The Bahamas produces little of its own food, most of which is consumed locally, and 80% of its food consumption is imported, mainly from the USA. The Government aims to expand food production to reduce imports and generate foreign exchange. The areas officially listed as the target for agricultural investment are beef and pork production and processing, fruits and nuts, dairy production, winter vegetables, and mariculture (shrimp farming). The fishing industry is the third largest sector of the economy after tourism and banking. The agriculture and fisheries industries account for 5% of GDP. Most of this comes from the export of the spiny lobster and Nassau grouper.



BARBADOS

Barbados is the most easterly of the Caribbean islands; it lies east of the Windward Islands and 460 km (285.7 mi) northwest of Venezuela. Approximately 37.21% of the total land area of 431 km² (167 sq mi) is arable. The island is composed mostly of coral and is relatively flat, rising gently to central highland region with the highest point being 336 m (1,104 ft) above sea level. The average annual rainfall is 1295 mm (51 inches).

Historically, the Barbadian economy has been dependent on sugarcane cultivation and related activities, but production in recent years has diversified into light industry and tourism. Barbados has a market based economy. Over the last four decades, the economy has shifted from an emphasis on agriculture towards the provision of services. The economy is now based on tourism, business, finance and general services, agriculture and manufacturing.

Since independence, Barbados has transformed itself from a low-income economy dependent upon sugar production to a middle-income economy based on tourism. Agriculture currently contributes 4% to GDP. Sugar accounts for 2.4% of GDP and 80% of arable land. The services sector is the largest contributor to the GDP at 78%. Nearly 2,000 hectares of land is cultivated for vegetables, most of which is used for domestic consumption. Over the last five years there has been an increase in fish tonnage.



BELIZE

Belize, formerly British Honduras, is a country in Central America. It was a British Territory, until it gained its independence in 1981. Belize has one of the lowest population densities in the world. The territory is 8,867 square miles (22,960 km²), and the population is 320,000 people (2008 est.). Belize associates primarily with the English-speaking Caribbean countries such as Jamaica, or Trinidad and Tobago.

According to the most recent surveys, about sixty percent (60%) of Belize is forested, with only about twenty percent (20%) of the country's land subject to human uses (such as agricultural land and human settlements). Belize's biodiversity is very rich, and about (37%) of Belize's land territory falls under some form of official protected status. Agriculture plays a key role in the economy, which is based primarily on agriculture, agro-based industry, and merchandising, with tourism and construction recently playing a more significant role. Sugar, the chief crop, accounts for nearly half of exports, while the banana industry being the country's largest employer.



DOMINICA

The Commonwealth of Dominica is the most northerly and largest of the Windward Islands. It is situated between Guadeloupe to the north and Martinique to the south. The volcanic island, known as the nature island of the Caribbean, covers 751 km² (290 mi²). It is heavily forested and is renowned for its lakes, waterfalls and over 365 rivers. The highest point rises to 1,524 km (5,000 ft) above sea level. The average annual rainfall is 1981 mm (78 inches). Dominica's fertile volcanic soil, frequent rainfall and extensive, luxuriant forests underpin the country's reliance on agriculture. The sector accounts for 18% of the GDP from bananas, citrus, coconuts, cocoa, herbal oils and extracts. Banana production employs, directly or indirectly, upwards of one-third of the work force. However, the sector is highly vulnerable to weather conditions and to external events affecting commodity prices and with the loss of the preferential EU markets for bananas, Dominica has diversified into other crops and small quantities of citrus fruits and vegetables are already being exported. Coffee, patchouli, aloe vera, cut flowers, mangoes, guavas, and papayas have also been introduced. Despite the rugged coastline, lack of beaches, and the absence of an international airport, tourism is becoming increasingly important and the Government is promoting the island as an "ecotourism" destination.



GRENADA

Grenada lies 135 km north of Trinidad. The island covers an area of 344 km² (133 mi²). Known as the Spice Island, Grenada consists of three main islands: Grenada, Carriacou and Petit Martinique. Grenada is volcanic in origin with a rugged, narrow coastal plain and central mountainous rainforests. The highest peak rises to 840 m (2,756 ft) above sea level. The average annual rainfall is 1524 mm (60 inches).

The economy of Grenada is dependent on agriculture and tourism. While tourism is the main source of foreign exchange, historically, the island has been an agricultural society. The agricultural sector accounts for 8% of GDP and the agro-processing sub-sector is becoming increasingly important. Export products are nutmeg, mace, cocoa, bananas, other fruits, vegetables and fish. Grenada is the second largest producer of nutmeg in the world and remains a significant producer of mace, cinnamon, ginger and cloves. More than a third of the population depends on nutmeg farming to earn a living.



GUYANA

Guyana is located on the northern coast of the South American continent. It is bounded by the Atlantic Ocean on the north, Brazil to the southwest, Suriname to the east and Venezuela to the northwest. It covers a land area of 214,970 km² (83,000 mi²). The climate is Equatorial, characterized by high humidity and seasonal rainfall in two rainy seasons (May to mid-August and mid-November to mid-January). The average annual rainfall is 2289 mm (90 inches).

Agriculture and mining remain Guyana's most important economic activities, with sugar, bauxite, rice and gold accounting for about 75% of export earnings. The Guyanese economy is making extremely slow progress due to low prices for its key commodities: bauxite and sugar. Agriculture accounts for about 37% of GDP and the Government continues to encourage investment in the sector. Among the products produced are sugar, rice, vegetable oils; beef, pork, poultry, dairy products; fish (shrimp). Sugar employs 18,500 people. Rice accounts for 4% of the country's GDP.

Guyana's food processing sector is poised to take off, especially with beef, poultry, dairy and soya bean. There is potential for the further development of the fishing sector.



Jamaica

Jamaica is located in the Caribbean Sea 145 km (90 mi) south of Cuba and 160 km (100 mi) west of Haiti. It covers a total land area of 11,000 km² (4,411 mi²) and is the third largest island in the Caribbean (the largest English-speaking). The interior is very mountainous rising to a height of 2,256 m. There are low coastal plains, scattered hills and plateaus, and numerous rivers and streams. The climate varies from tropical and humid at sea level to temperate in the mountain areas. The average annual rainfall is 1000 mm (36 inches). Jamaica's natural resources - primarily bauxite, adequate water supplies, and climate, makes it conducive to mining, agriculture and tourism. The economy is heavily dependent on services, which now account for 70% of GDP. The country continues to derive most of its foreign exchange from tourism, remittances, and bauxite/alumina.

At 6%, agriculture is the lowest contributor to GDP, but it employs 20% of the workforce. Sugar remains the main crop, with bananas the second largest export crop. Coffee production is gaining in importance. Other leading products include cocoa, citrus, yams, vegetables, poultry, goats, milk, crustaceans, and molluscs. Jamaica currently grows the entire world supply of allspice.



ST. KITTS & NEVIS

The Federation of St Kitts and Nevis is a part of the Leeward Islands group, lying about 200 miles southwest of Puerto Rico and to the north of the Windward Island group. The islands cover a total land area of 269 km² (104 mi²). Separated by a two-mile stretch of water, St Kitts is 176 km² (68 mi²) and Nevis is 93 km² (36 mi²).

Sugar was the traditional mainstay of the Saint Kitts economy until the 1970s. With nearly half of the country's workforce involved in the sugar industry, the crop still dominates the agricultural sector. Faced with a sugar industry that was finding it increasingly difficult to earn a profit, the Government of St. Kitts and Nevis embarked on a program to diversify the agricultural sector and stimulate the development of other sectors of the economy. By 1987, tourism had surpassed sugar as the major foreign exchange earner for St. Kitts and Nevis. Export-oriented manufacturing and offshore banking have also assumed larger roles in the economy.

The country's fertile soil is ideal for producing most agricultural crops and there is an adequate supply of groundwater for irrigation. The Government is implementing an ongoing program of agricultural diversification with emphasis on crops and livestock such as dairy, beef, mutton, pork and poultry. Agriculture contributes 5% of GDP.



St. Lucia

St. Lucia is one of the Windward Islands. It lies 21 miles to the south of Martinique, 26 miles to the north of St. Vincent and 110 miles north-west of Barbados. It covers a total land area of 616 km² (238 mi²). The island is volcanic and mountainous with broad fertile valleys intersected by numerous short rivers. The highest peak is 959 m (3,145 ft). The rainy season is from June to November with an average rainfall ranging from 1,524 to 3,505mm (60 to 138 inches).

Agriculture accounts for some 30,000 jobs; the establishment of tree crops such as mangos and avocados is being encouraged. A variety of vegetables are produced for local consumption.

The island has been able to attract foreign business and investment, especially in its offshore banking and tourism industries. The manufacturing sector is the most diverse in the Eastern Caribbean area. Recently, St. Lucia added small, computer-driven information technology and financial services as development objectives.



ST VINCENT & THE GRENADINES

St. Vincent is situated in the Windward Islands at the lower end of the Caribbean chain; the Grenadines comprise a chain of little islands and rocks between St. Vincent and Grenada. The total land area is 389 km² (150 mi²) with St. Vincent covering 344 km².

The economy of St Vincent and the Grenadines is based largely on agriculture, which accounts for 10% of the GDP.

The service sector is growing and features tourism, telephone e-marketing and a small offshore financial centre. These include promoting private sector growth, restructuring of the banana industry, and agricultural diversification. Among the agricultural products traditionally produced are: coconuts, sweet potatoes, eddoes, dasheen, arrowroot starch, spices as well as small numbers of cattle, sheep, pigs, goats and fish.

The improvement in banana production came at a time when regional producers were confronting a number of challenges in this market, including the erosion of preferential market access, unfavourable prices and high production costs. The production of more non-traditional crops, particularly in the OECS countries increased as farmers sought to reduce earnings risk. Among the food crops showing increased output values were plantains, pineapples, yams and peppers.



SURINAME

The Republic of Suriname is located on the north coast of South America; bordered by Guyana on the west, Brazil on the south, French Guiana on the east, and the Atlantic Ocean to the North. The total land is 163,820 km² (63,251 mi²). Seventy five per cent of the country is densely forested with low flat plains in the northern coastal area and intermittent savannahs in the central zone. The highest point is 1,255 m (4,120 ft). Suriname is located outside of the hurricane zone. There are two short dry seasons between two periods of heavy rainfall. The average rainfall is 209 mm (8.2 inches).

The Surinamese economy is dominated by the bauxite industry, which accounts for 70% of export earnings. Suriname produces rice, bananas and plantains, shrimp and a variety of tropical fruits and vegetables. Agriculture's contribution to GDP is 13% and it represents an important growth area with export potential. The Government is re-organizing the state-controlled banana industry and has embarked on efforts to increase the exports of beef, bananas, flowers and fresh vegetables to the CARICOM and EU markets. The state owns a fleet of shrimp trawlers, which earn about US\$32 million per annum.



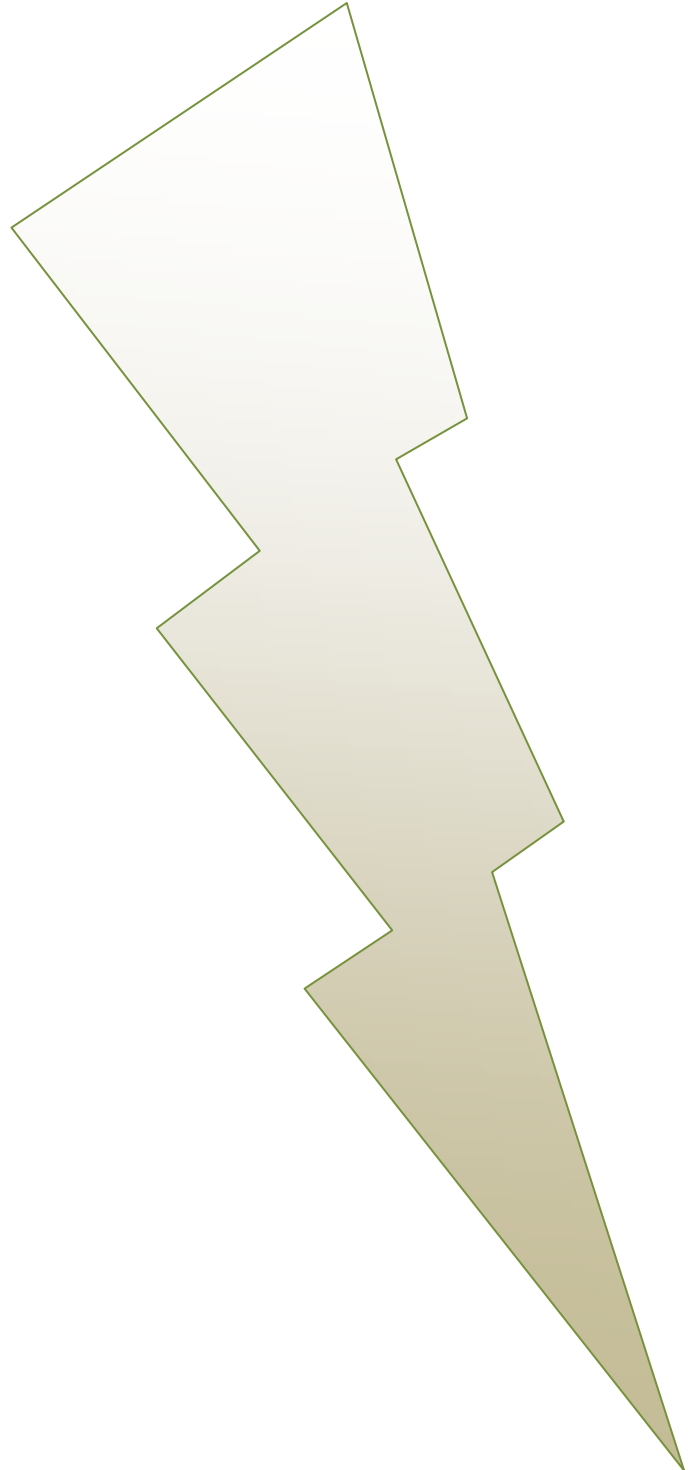
TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Trinidad and Tobago are the southernmost islands of the Lesser Antilles chain. Geographically, they are an extension of the South American continent; separated from Venezuela by 11 km (7 mi). The island of Trinidad is 30 km (19 mi) from Tobago. The total land area covered by the twin islands is 5,128 km² (1,980 mi²). Trinidad covers 4,828 km² (1,864 mi²) while Tobago covers 300 km² (117 mi²). Half of Trinidad is mostly plains with some hills and low mountains covered with tropical forests, the east and west coasts are partially swampy, their highest elevation reaches 940 m (3,085 ft).

Tobago has scenic beaches and a main ridge of volcanic origin along the centre, reaching a maximum height of 549 m (1,800 ft); the dry season generally runs from January to May with a wet season from June to December. The annual rainfall is 1,869 mm (73.6 inches). Trinidad and Tobago is endowed with rich deposits of oil. It is the leading Caribbean producer of oil and gas and the third biggest exporter of petroleum of the Western Hemisphere. New large oil and gas discoveries and a series of new projects, expected to come on line in the next three years, are expected to help double energy production by 2007. The production is expected to taper off in 2020 and, in preparation, the Government is focusing on diversification efforts that include agriculture and manufacturing.

Tourism is a growing sector, although not proportionally as important as in many other Caribbean islands. Agriculture accounts for only about 2% of the GDP. Trinidad and Tobago's main export crops are sugar, cocoa, coffee and citrus. Flowers have also become an export commodity for the country and the Government has on-going plans to develop non-traditional agricultural crops for export as well. Sugar production accounts for nearly 50% of agricultural output and in 2000 represented 1% of total exports.

The unprofitability of sugar production and refining has led the Government to restructure the island's company with the goal of downsizing sugar production by half by the end of 2004.
